"CAN WA has had a strong relationship with the State Library from the start of the Bush Babies project, and this partnership has allowed many Noongar families to find and repatriate treasured family photos," said CAN WA's General Manager, Monica Kane.

The photographs on display feature Elders from Narrogin, Katanning, Quairading and Kellerberrin.

At the heart of the exhibition is a tribute to 100 year-old Hazel Winmar, who is believed to be the oldest Noongar woman alive.

The exhibition is free and open to the public every day except during the public holidays, until October 2014.
